

A NOTE ON ASSESSMENT

Dear Parents,

Kindly note the assessment plan of your ward for the current academic year. Please go through the criteria in detail and guide the child accordingly.

The total marks are split into two components - **content** based written test and **skill** based assessment.

Periodic Test 1 and 2 (50 marks each)	Written Tests: 20 marks each (PT 1 and PT2) Skill based assessment: 30 marks each (participation in experiential learning activities, contribution in Audio Visual Lab activities, individual project presentations, class projects -ISA and regularity in classwork and homework)
Mid Term Exam (50 marks)	Written Test
Cumulative Assessment	PT1 + PT2 + MID TERM = 100 MARKS Only grades will reflect in the report cards

Skill based assessment:

Assessment criteria will record the child's response to diverse learning situations and this involves a variety of parameters. It provides multiple opportunities for a student to demonstrate his/her learning as against assessment based on test papers only. The assessment criteria is aligned to the **objectives of the primary curriculum** and helps the child modify his/her behaviour. It includes self and peer evaluation.

- **Experiential learning** includes hands on activities as mentioned below subject wise:

English/ Hindi:: debate, role play, Just A Minute, long poem recitation, dramatisation, library book review

Maths: number games, group and individual activities that include outdoor explorations, puzzles and sudoku exercises

EVS/GSc/ S.St:: nature study, experiments in the class and lab, field trips

- **Audio Visual activities:** Follow up of and take away from audio visual lessons
- **Passion project:** Individual project presentations that the student has work at
- **Collaborative projects:** Class projects taken up each year. Example ISA project in the current year
- **Classwork/Homework:** Class tests and revision tests, regularity of work, neatness in work presentation, follow up work, index, self evaluation
